NOTES:

- 1) All chord changes are on the 4/4 beat.
- 2) The melody is syncopated between the chords.
- 3) Some chords are played by themselves, with the lyric words immediately following.
- 4) Chords played by themselves are shown over gaps in the lyric lines.
- 5) Chords played with the lyrics are shown over the lyric word.
