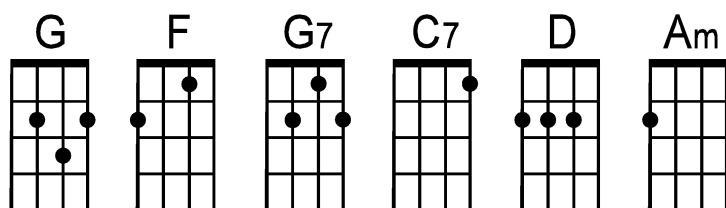


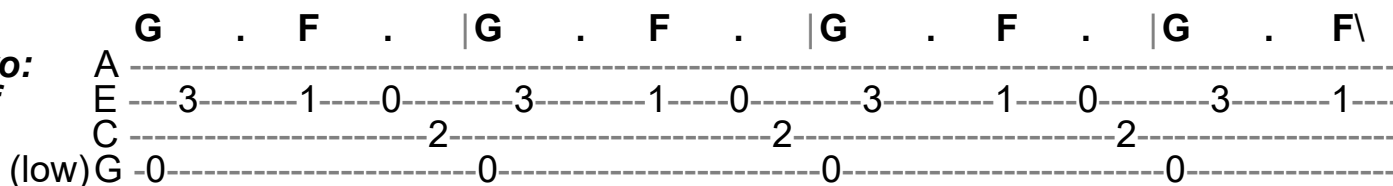
# Last Train to Clarksville
