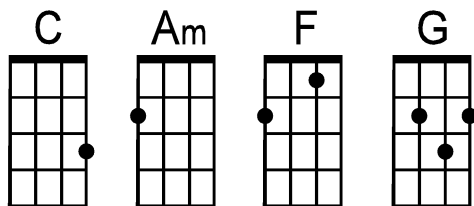


Up on the Roof (Key of C)
